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Huber Honored for Dedication to Northwest Chapter

ALEXANDRIA, VA—Chris Huber, president of Virtual Systems, Bellevue, WA was presented with the Robert M. Huse Chapter Achievement Award for his major contributions and dedication to the Northwest Chapter of MFSA. The award was given out at MFSA's Annual Conference, held in Charleston, SC, earlier this month.

Previous recipient of the award and second vice chairman of the MFSA board of directors Ted Kulpinski said in presenting the award, "Huber has been the 'glue' that has held the Northwest Chapter together over the last eight years."
